This weekend marks the official launch of our St. Agnes's capital campaign – an important effort to help fund needed facility repair and improvement projects and pay off our debt owed to the diocese. Earlier this week, parishioners were mailed a packet of materials about our campaign. A case statement booklet is enclosed, along with a letter from Fr. Bob requesting a pledge to the effort. Over the coming weeks, our team of volunteers will be reaching out to families to discuss the campaign, answer questions and seek your support. Due to our limited numbers of volunteers, we may not be able to personally contact every family – but we do hope that all families will choose to participate in this important campaign.

Why does the campaign encourage pledges? Pledges provide flexibility in making a gift by spreading the gift amount over a three-year period. It allows donors to make more substantial gifts than those making one-time gifts. Donors are asked to sign a pledge card to record their intentions which allows the parish to budget for debt and project expenditures. A pledge card represents intent and is not a legally binding document.

Will there be transparency in the amount of funds raised and the use of those funds? During the campaign and the ensuing pledge period, weekly campaign reports will appear in the bulletin. Campaign funds will be kept in a separate account and can only be used for the reasons stated in the case statement.

Why do we need outside counsel for the campaign? We do not have the expertise, time, or staff to run a successful campaign alone. The Steier Group has an excellent history of running successful campaigns in Catholic parishes, schools and organizations. The group comes highly recommended, especially for its “hands-on” management style.



Signature Ads: We will have sign-ups for the annual Springfield Right to Life Signature ad in the Gathering Space after all Masses this weekend, January 19-20. This is a great opportunity to show your support for life on the anniversary of the infamous Supreme Court decision *Roe v. Wade* which legalized abortion on demand at any stage of pregnancy. Cost of one line is \$5.00 and can consist of a single name, several names, an organization or a family name. Your participation is appreciated.
