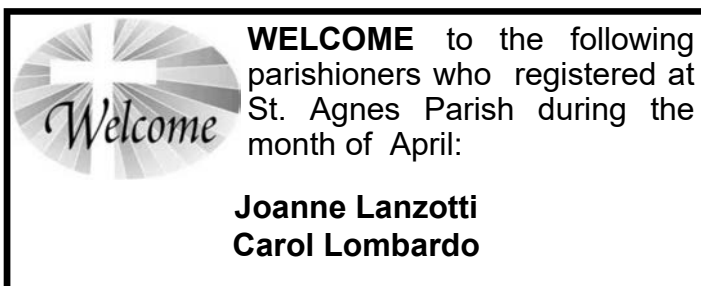


Dominican Faith Camp Registration Now Open
