St. Vincent DePaul Society Annual Collection June 9-10:

The St. Vincent DePaul Society of St. Agnes has been providing assistance to the poor and misfortunate of our Parish and the community for over 20 years. SVD services include casework assistance (roughly 290 cases totaling over \$50,000 in aid). The need for casework assistance is growing. So far, in 2018, we have received requests and assisted 13 individuals totaling over \$1,900. In addition to casework assistance, St. Vincent DePaul also provides a St. John's Breadline meal on the first Saturday of each month. The 12 breadline meals are split into two teams of volunteers which rotate sloppy joe and/or dessert preparation. If you wish to join the St. Vincent DePaul Society, please leave your contact information with the rectory at 793-1330. New volunteers are always welcome.

A second collection will be held for the St. Vincent DePaul Society the weekend of June 9-10. A donation envelope is included in this bulletin. Thank you for over 20 years of financial and volunteer support.
