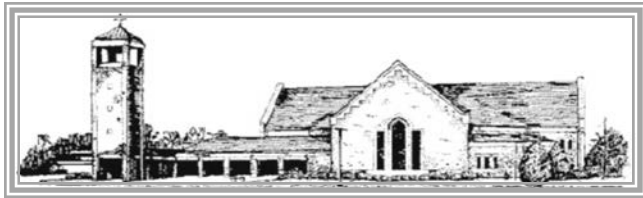

Christ the King Fall Bible Study:

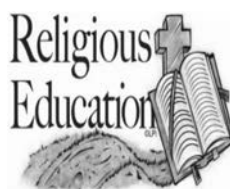
