Dear Friends in Christ,

This year marks the 200th anniversary of one of the most popular and beloved Christmas carols – "Silent Night" – the music composed by Franz Gruber and the lyrics by Joseph Mohr. It was first performed during Christmas Eve Mass in 1818 in the little church of St. Nicholas in Oberndorf, Austria. The poetic words and tender melody of this song are most touching and soothing.

Recently our music director, Karen Ferguson, shared a contemporary offshoot of this famous carol entitled "Somewhere in Your Silent Night" by the Christian music group, Casting Crowns. It will be sung as a prelude to the 10:00 p.m. Christmas Eve Mass on December 24. The lyrics explore a bit more the implications of that "Silent Night"
